To celebrate the success of the young women's group, they got the opportunity to go on a residential.


The group went to East Coast Adventure Centre in Rostrevor.

Our Junior Christmas party was a great success this year!


We had a candy card, build-a-bear, inflatable Santa's grotto and disco.
